

privacy statement

We take the protection of your personal information very seriously.

Your privacy on bizunlimited!

This website is administered by bizunlimited! We want you to feel secure when visiting our site and are committed to maintaining your privacy when doing so. The information below provides an overview of how we protect your privacy whenever you are on this site.

What data do we gather?

Data on bizunlimited! is gathered in two ways: indirectly (for example, through cookies) and/or directly (for example, when you provide information on various response forms). This information includes your Internet address so that we can track unique visits to our site for analytic purposes.

We collect information when you choose to submit it to us. Throughout our site, for example, we provide the opportunity to register for an event or conference or participate in an online survey. When we collect this type of information, we will notify you of the reason we are asking for information and how this information will be used. It is completely up to you whether or not you want to provide it.

We also collect information directly from you in a number of ways, some of which we describe in this Privacy Statement (where we do not describe it here it is described at the point of collection). One way is through the use of cookies. The cookies we use identify you only as a number unless specifically stated otherwise at the place you choose to accept a cookie. (You can disable cookies on your computer by changing the settings in preferences or options menu in your browser. If unsure how please consult your software's "help" section.)

How do we use this information?

The information isn't used for anything more than to determine what is most effective about our site, to help us identify ways to improve it and to determine how we can tailor bizunlimited! to make it more effective. We may also use data for other purposes, which we would describe to you at the point we collect the information – for example if you were invited to register for an event, or to subscribe to a newsletter.

Do we share your information with outside parties?

Any data we collect may be transferred internationally throughout bizunlimited!'s organization. We don't sell individual information and we share it only with our advisors, suppliers, franchisees and members. But again, before you submit any information, we will notify you of the reason we are asking you for specific information, and it is then up to you whether or not you want to provide it.

What about sensitive personal data?

We do not typically collect sensitive personal data through this site. If we do seek to collect such data, we will ask you to consent to our proposed uses of the data. We may also collect some sensitive personal data incidentally. By providing us with unsolicited sensitive personal data, you consent to our using the data subject to applicable law as described in this Privacy Statement. The

references to "sensitive personal data" are to the various categories of personal data identified by European and other data privacy laws as requiring special treatment, including in some circumstances the need to obtain explicit consent. These categories comprise personal identity numbers, personal data about personality and private life, racial or ethnic origin, nationality, political opinions, membership of political parties or movements, religious, philosophical or other similar beliefs, membership of a trade union or profession or trade association, physical or mental health, genetic code, addictions, sexual life, property matters or criminal record (including information about suspected criminal activities).

Do we give you access to your information?

You are entitled to know whether we hold information about you and, if we do, to have access to that information and require it to be corrected if it is inaccurate. You can do this by contacting us online via our order form, via our privacy centre or by email via privacy@bizunlimited.com

What about data security?

We take appropriate steps to maintain the security of your data wherever it may be in bizunlimited!. The open nature of the Internet is such that data may flow over networks without security measures and may be accessed and used by people other than those for whom the data is intended. There's not much we or anyone else can do about this, suffice it to say we aim to apply appropriate levels of security at all times.

How long do we keep data for?

We keep data for three years after which inactive data records are destroyed. Data files and records we process on behalf of clients are destroyed as soon as the contract expires. All transactional and financial data is held in secure archive for a minimum of six years in accordance with UK best practice.
